

# V-Stitch Blanket

This blanket really is a classic that anyone can tackle. All you need is a bunch of your favourite coloured yarns - as many or as few as you like - and you're away. Using just a one row repeat this is the perfect beginner project to practise your technique and tension.



DK yarn of your choice - approx 200g



5mm/H



The finished blanket measures 65cm by 75cm



12st and 8 rows =10cm by 10cm

## V-STITCH BLANKET



About 200g of any double knit wool of your choice



5mm/H



The finished blanket measures 65cm by 75cm



12st and 8 rows = 10cm by 10cm



ch = chain
chsp = chain space
dc = double crochet
htr = half treble
tr = treble
rep = repeat
RS = right side
sk = skip
sp = space
ss = slip stitch

WS = wrong side



#### **PATTERN:**

**Foundation chain:** ch79 (multiple of 2+1)

Row 1: 2tr in 4th ch from hook, \*skip 1, 2tr in next, rep from \* to last, tr in last st

Row 2: ch3 (counts as st), \*2tr in between each set of 2tr to create the 'V' stitch, rep from \* across to last, tr in last st

**Rows 3-60:** Repeat Row 2 changing colour each row.

#### US

chain ch slip stitch ss single crochet sc half double hdc double dc treble tr double treble dtr
