Cozy, warm and packed full of texture this gorgeous cable headband pattern comes in sizes baby to adult for all the family. The perfect quick and easy gift to crochet.

### **YARN**

### Yarn: <u>Brava Worsted</u> 100% acrylic, 208yds/100g

Approx 150yds per headband

### HOOK

A 5.5mm(I) <u>crochet hook</u> or hook needed to meet gauge

### OTHER MATERIALS

### GAUGE

<u>Scissors</u> <u>Tapestry needle</u> 12 sts and 16 rounds measure 10cm x 10cm (4" x 4")

### SIZING

## Size To fit head Finished size in/cm in/cm

Baby up to 18/45.5 13.5/34.5 Child up to 21/53.5 16.75/42.5 Adult up to 24/61 20/51

100% acrylic 252yds, 230m/140g

### Sirdar Country Classic Worsted

50% wool, 50% acrylic 218yds, 200m/100g

### Swish Worsted by WeCrochet

100% superwash merino wool 110yds, 100m/50g

### **GLOSSARY**

ch(s) - chain(s)

sp - space

ss - slip stitch

RS - right side

WS - wrong side

sk - skip

rep - repeat

yoh - yarn over hook

blo - back loop only

FP - front post

BP - back post

### Henrietta Cable Headband

### **NOTES**

- The headband is worked in rounds after creating a row of foundation stitches that are joined to form the band.
- A chl at the beginning of a round does not count as a
- All post stitches are worked into the stitches 2 rounds below.

### STITCH KEY

#### **UK Terms**

dc - double crochet fdc - foundation double crochet fsc - foundation single crochet htr - half treble tr - treble crochet dtr - double treble crochet

#### **US Terms**

sc - single crochet hdc - half double crochet dc - double crochet tr - treble crochet

### SPECIAL STITCHES

### **Back Post Stitch**

To work the back post, yarn over, reaching over top of the piece and working on opposite or right side of the work, insert the hook from right to left around vertical post of next stitch, yarn over and complete the stitch.

### Front Post Stitch

To work the front post, yarn over, insert hook from front to back and to front again around the vertical post (upright part) of next st, yoh and draw yarn through, yoh and complete stitch.

**UK Terminology** 

BABY SIZE: 2" deep.

Row 1: fdc 40 stitches, taking care not to twist, ss to 1st st to form a ring [40] work in rounds now.

Round 1: ch1, dc in each st around, ss in 1st to join.

Round 2: ch1, \*dc in next, skip 2 sts, FPdtr in next 2, working behind the 2 sts just made, FPdtr in 2 skipped sts, FPtr in next 2, dc in next, FPtr in next 2; rep from \* around, ss in 1st to join.

Round 3: Rep Round 1.

Round 4: ch1, \*dc in next, FPtr in next 2, skip next 2 sts, FPdtr in next 2, working in front of sts just made, FPdtr in next 2, dc in next, skip next st, FPdtr in next, working in front of the st just made, FPdtr in skipped st; rep from \* around, ss in 1st to join.

Round 5: Rep Round 1.

Rounds 6-7: Repeat Rounds 2-3.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

CHILD SIZE: 3" deep

**Row 1:** fdc 50 stitches, taking care not to twist, ss to 1st st to form a ring [50] work in rounds now.

Round 1: ch1, dc in each st around, ss in 1st to join.

Round 2: ch1, \*dc in next, skip 2 sts, FPdtr in next 2, working behind the 2 sts just made, FPdtr in 2 skipped sts, FPtr in next 2, dc in next, FPtr in next 2; rep from \* around, ss in 1st to join.

Round 3: Rep Round 1.



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Round 4: ch1, \*dc in next, FPtr in next 2, skip next 2 sts, FPdtr in next 2, working in front of sts just made, FPdtr in next 2, dc in next, skip next st, FPdtr in next, working in front of the st just made, FPdtr in skipped st; rep from \* around, ss in 1st to join.

Round 5: Rep Round 1.

Rounds 6-9: Repeat Rounds 2-5

Rounds 10-11: Repeat Rounds 2-3.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

ADULT SIZE: 4" deep

Row 1: fdc 60 stitches, taking care not to twist, ss to 1st st to form a ring [60] work in rounds now.

Round 1: ch1, dc in each st around, ss in 1st to join.

Round 2: ch1, \*dc in next, skip 2 sts, FPdtr in next 2, working behind the 2 sts just made, FPdtr in 2 skipped sts, FPtr in next 2, dc in next, FPtr in next 2; rep from \* around, ss in 1st to join.

Round 3: Rep Round 1.

Round 4: ch1, \*dc in next, FPtr in next 2, skip next 2 sts, FPdtr in next 2, working in front of sts just made, FPdtr in next 2, dc in next, skip next st, FPdtr in next, working in front of the st just made, FPdtr in skipped st; rep from \* around, ss in 1st to join.

Round 5: Rep Round 1.

Rounds 6-13: Repeat Rounds 2-5

Rounds 14-15: Repeat Rounds 2-3.

Round 16: Rep Round 1.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

### **PATTERN**

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US Terminology

BABY SIZE: 2" deep.

Row 1: fsc 40 stitches, taking care not to twist, ss to 1st st to form a ring [40] work in rounds now.

Round 1: ch1, sc in each st around, ss in 1st to join.

Round 2: ch1, \*sc in next, skip 2 sts, FPtr in next 2, working behind the 2 sts just made, FPtr in 2 skipped sts, FPdc in next 2, sc in next, FPdc in next 2; rep from \* around, ss in 1st to join.

Round 3: Rep Round 1.

Round 4: ch1, \*sc in next, FPdc in next 2, skip next 2 sts, FPtr in next 2, working in front of sts just made, FPtr in next 2, sc in next, skip next st, FPtr in next, working in front of the st just made, FPtr in skipped st; rep from \* around, ss in 1st to join.

Round 5: Rep Round 1.

Rounds 6-7: Repeat Rounds 2-3.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

CHILD SIZE: 3" deep

**Row 1:** fsc 50 stitches, taking care not to twist, ss to 1st st to form a ring [50] work in rounds now.

Round 1: ch1, sc in each st around, ss in 1st to join.

Round 2: ch1, \*sc in next, skip 2 sts, FPtr in next 2, working behind the 2 sts just made, FPtr in 2 skipped sts, FPdc in next 2, sc in next, FPdc in next 2; rep from \* around, ss in 1st to join.

Round 3: Rep Round 1.

Round 4: ch1, \*sc in next, FPdc in next 2, skip next 2 sts, FPtr in next 2, working in front of sts just made, FPtr in next 2, sc in next, skip next st, FPtr in next, working in front of the st just made, FPtr in skipped st; rep from \* around, ss in 1st to join.

Round 5: Rep Round 1.

Rounds 6-9: Repeat Rounds 2-5

Rounds 10-11: Repeat Rounds 2-3.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

ADULT SIZE: 4" deep

Row 1: fsc 60 stitches, taking care not to twist, ss to 1st st to form a ring [60] work in rounds now.

Round 1: ch1, sc in each st around, ss in 1st to join.

Round 2: ch1, \*sc in next, skip 2 sts, FPtr in next 2, working behind the 2 sts just made, FPtr in 2 skipped sts, FPdc in next 2, sc in next, FPdc in next 2; rep from \* around, ss in 1st to join.

Round 3: Rep Round 1.

Round 4: ch1, \*sc in next, FPdc in next 2, skip next 2 sts, FPtr in next 2, working in front of sts just made, FPtr in next 2, sc in next, skip next st, FPtr in next, working in front of the st just made, FPtr in skipped st; rep from \* around, ss in 1st to join.

Round 5: Rep Round 1.

Rounds 6-13: Repeat Rounds 2-5

Rounds 14-15: Repeat Rounds 2-3.

Round 16: Rep Round 1.

Fasten off and weave in ends.
