



# Cute Cat Eye Mask

With teeny little ears and a simple bow to finish off, this cute crochet eye mask is just the thing for cat lovers! Easily adjustable to fit anyone by adding the length of elastic you want it's the perfect thing for sleeping or just chilling!



## YARN

Cotlin DK; 70% Tanguis Cotton, 30% Linen, 123yds/50g

A: Flamingo (approx 90yds)  
B Linen or Swan (approx 15 yds)

## HOOK

A 3.5mm (E/4) crochet hook

## OTHER MATERIALS

Scissors  
Tapestry needle  
32cm of 8mm pink elastic (or to fit desired head)

## GAUGE

20 sts and 20 rows = 10cm by 10cm/ 4" by 4" but isn't essential in this project.

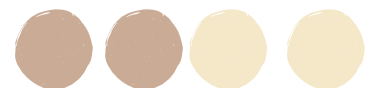


## SIZING

The finished eye mask measures 18cm by 11cm and will fit an average child to adult with your choice of elastic for the back.

## DIFFICULTY

Easy

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## YARN ALTERNATIVES

### Rico Essentials Cotton DK

100% cotton; 120m/50g

### DROPS Cotton Merino

50% fine merino, 50% Egyptian cotton; 110m/50g

### Lion Brand Cotton Bamboo

52% cotton, 48% Rayon from bamboo, 224m/100g

## GLOSSARY

ch(s) - chain(s)  
sp - space  
ss - slip stitch  
RS - right side  
WS - wrong side  
sk - skip  
rep - repeat  
yoh - yarn over hook  
tog - together  
st(s) - stitch(es)

## NOTES

- a ch1 at the beginning of a row does not count as a stitch.
- Turn your work at the end of each Row.
- the eye mask is made from a matching front and back panel that are then crocheted together.
- the bow is made separately and then sewn in place wherever you would like it.
- Secure your choice of elastic or tie to the back of the eye mask once complete making sure to be aware of safety if the mask is for a child or vulnerable person.

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## PATTERN

### *US Terminology*

#### TO MAKE THE EYEMASK:

Using A make 2 sides to join together.

**Foundation chain:** ch26

**Row 1:** (RS) sc in 2nd ch from hook and each across [25].

**Row 2:** ch1, 2sc in 1st st, sc in next 23 sts, 2sc in last st [27].

**Row 3:** ch1, 2sc in 1st st, sc in next 25 sts, 2sc in last st [29].

**Row 4:** ch1, 2sc in 1st st, sc in next 27 sts, 2sc in last st [31].

**Row 5:** ch1, 2sc in 1st st, sc in next 29 sts, 2sc in last st [33].

**Row 6:** ch1, 2sc in 1st st, sc in next 31 sts, 2sc in last st [35].

**Row 7:** ch1, 2sc in 1st st, sc in next 33 sts, 2sc in last st [37].

**Rows 8-11:** ch1, sc in each st across [37].

**Row 12:** ch1, sc2tog, sc in next 33 sts, sc2tog [35].

**Row 13:** ch1, sc2tog, sc in next 31 sts, sc2tog [33].

**Row 14:** ch1, sc2tog, sc in next 29 sts, sc2tog [31].

**Row 15:** ch1, sc2tog, sc in next 27 sts, sc2tog [29].

**Row 16:** ch1, sc in each st across [29].

**Row 17:** ch1, sc in next 11sts, ss in next 7sts, sc in next 11sts [29].

**Row 18:** ch1, sc2tog, sc in next 7 sts, sc2tog, ss in next 7 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 7sts, sc2tog [25].

**Row 19:** ch1, sc2tog, sc in next 5 sts, sc2tog, ss in next 7 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 5 sts, sc2tog [21]. Fasten off.

#### EARS:

With RS facing, for the first ear join to top right hand st, for the second ear join to 8sts in from top left hand corner.

**Row 1:** ch1, sc in next 8 sts [8].

**Row 2:** sc2tog, sc in next 4 sts, sc2tog [6].

**Row 3:** sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog [4].

**Row 4:** sc2tog twice [2].

**Row 5:** sc2tog [1] Fasten off.

#### TO JOIN TOGETHER:

**Row 1:** With WS facing each other, join together with a sc seam, using 3sc in the top of each ear.

Sew the desired length of elastic in place to the back of the mask.

#### BOW:

**Foundation chain:** Using B, ch12.

**Row 1:** sc in 2nd ch from hook and each across [11].

**Rows 2-3:** ch1, sc in each st across [11].

Wind the yarn around the middle of the bow as many times as desired and pull tight to shape before sewing on.

Weave in all ends to complete.
