 <b>YARN WEIGHTS</b>	 <b>YARN TYPES</b>	 <b>HOOK SIZES*</b>	 <b>MOST COMMON PROJECTS</b>
<b>0</b> lace	Fingering, 10-count crochet thread	B/1 (2.25mm) or Steel Hooks	Doilies, shawls, lace items
<b>1</b> super fine	Sock, Fingering, Baby	B/1 (2.25mm) to E/4(3.5mm)	Socks, shawls, lace items, baby items
<b>2</b> fine	Sport, Baby	E/4(3.5mm) to 7 (4.5mm)	Lightweight garments, baby items
<b>3</b> light	Double Knit, Light Worsted	G/6(4mm) to I/9 (5.5mm)	Garments, baby blankets
<b>4</b> medium	Worsted, Afghan, Aran	H/8(5mm) to K/10.5 (6.5mm)	Hats, scarves, accessories, blankets
<b>5</b> bulky	Chunky, Craft, Rug	K/10.5 (6.5mm) to M/13 (9mm)	Blankets, rugs, scarves
<b>6</b> super bulky	Super Bulky, Roving	M/13 (9mm) to Q (15mm)	Blankets, baskets
<b>7</b> jumbo	Jumbo, Roving	Q (15mm) or above	Large blankets

\*hook sizes are as guidance and can vary dramatically depending on the drape you want to achieve.
